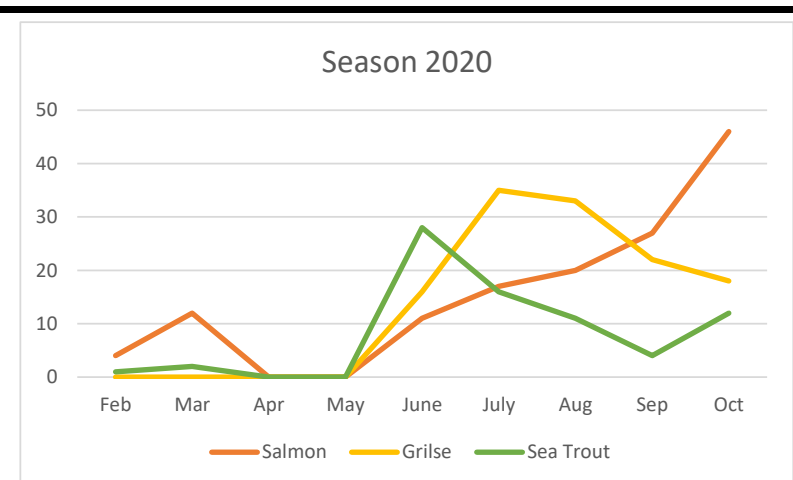


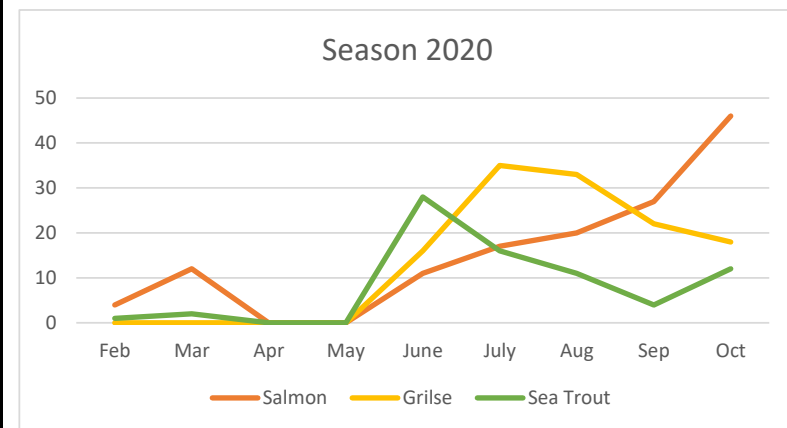


<b>Week 1</b>	Season Closed
<b>Week 2</b>	Season Closed
<b>Week 3</b> 17-02-20 to 22-02-20	Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Unfortunately no fish were caught on the opening week. Conditions were not great with the water being too high on most days.
<b>Week 4</b> 24-02-20 to 29-02-20	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1 4 fish caught this week. Cracking 12lb Salmon caught by Mr I Marshal of Falkirk the fish took a Howler Monkey and was caught on Blue Stone pool. Mr M Thomson from Bonnybridge had a 15lb fish from the Luther pool on a Vision110. Mr J Murray had a 2lb Sea Trout from the Boat pool. Mr C White had a 6lb fish on a Toby and Mr S Connally caught a 9lb fish on a Blue Toby.



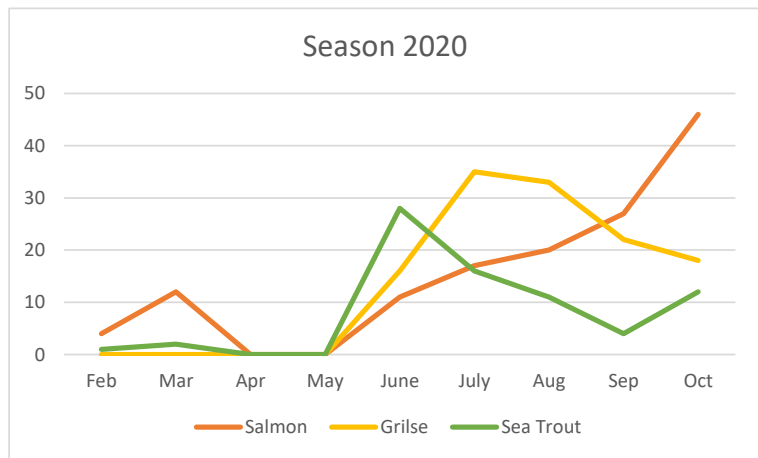


<b>Week 1</b> 02-03-20 to 07-03-20	Caught this week Salmon = 5 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Nice 14lb fish caught this week by Mr J Stewart from Larbet, the fish took a Devon Minnow from Bridges. Mr Sandground from Flkirk had 2 fish both around the 8lb mark one on a Rapala and one on a Willie Gunn both from Upper Weir. Mr J Murray from Dundonald also had 2 fish both on the Flying C and both from Upper Stobb, one of 6lbs and one of 4lbs. Conditions are looking good for the next week.
<b>Week 2</b> 09-03-20 to 14-03-20	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 2 Biggest fish this week was a 13lbr taken from the Luther Pool on an Icemaiden fly by Mr C White from Ayresshire. Mr T Monaghan from Stirling had a nice 8lb fish on the Monkey from Upper Stobb and Mr D Gossar had a 7lb fish on a Vision110 from Lower Weir. Sea trout seem to be making an early appearance with 2 being caught this week both around the 2-1/2lb mark and both from the Luther pool.
<b>Week 3</b> 16-03-20 to 21-03-20	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Mr D Leiper from Pert Farm took a nice 12lb fish from the Bridges on a Black Tube fly. Mr J Murray from Dundonald had a 7lb fish from the Luther pool and Mr J Clarence from Belfast had 2 fish of 3lb and 7lb also from the Luther pool all three fish were caught on a Flying C.

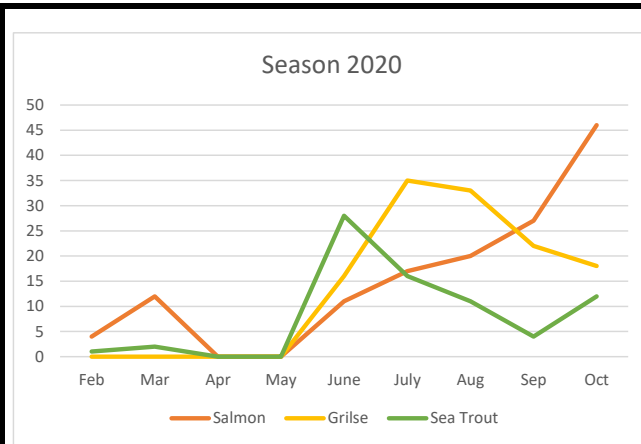

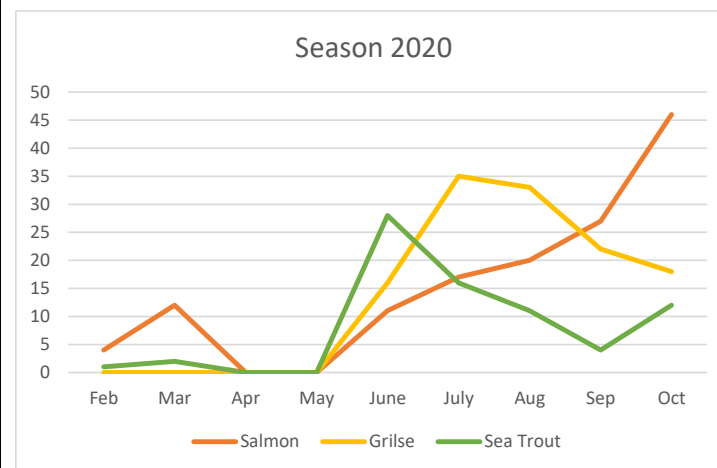

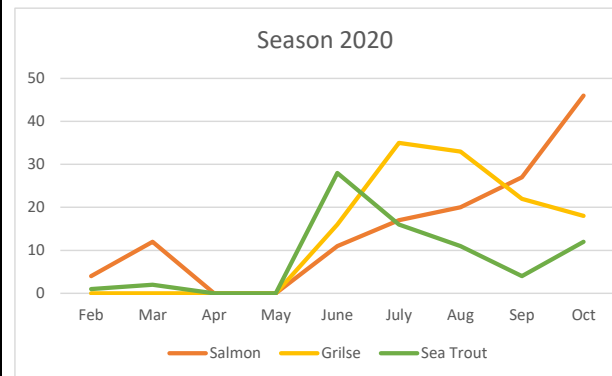


<b>Week 1</b> 01-06-20 to 06-06-20	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 13 Well we are back fishing at last. The river has been very low with very little rain which may account for the lack of salmon. SeaTrout were there in numbers with 13 caught for the week the biggest being 4lb caught by Mr C Colvon at the Luther Pool. The biggest Salmon was 10lbs caught by Mr D Wilson in the Boat Pool. Mr G Wyllie and Mr J Murray had an 8lb and 9lb fish respectively, both from the Luther Pool. All fish were returned apart from 1 Salmon and a SeaTrout.
<b>Week 2</b> 08-06-20 to 13-06-20	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 6 River still pretty low but fish are still trickling in with Seatrout showing signs of recovery. Mr J Miller had a good day catching a 10lb salmon a Grilse of 3-1/2 lbs and a Seatrout of 3-1/2lbs. Mr A Browne had a Grise of 4lbs.
<b>Week 3</b> 15-06-20 to 20-06-20	Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 5 Sea Trout = 3 Seatrout and Grilse being main catches this week. Mr C Halliday had a 4lb Grilse and a 3-1/2lb Seatrout from the Boat pool on a Mini tube fly. The next day Mr Halliday had another 3-1/2lb Grilse from the Luther pool again on the fly.
<b>Week 4</b> 22-06-20 to 30-06-20	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 9 Sea Trout = 6 Again Grilse and Seatrout are appearing in numbers a rise in the water is bringing them in to the system. Just to buck the trend Mr J Hammerawn had a 10lb Salmon on a Flamethrower from the Boat pool. Mr D Leiper had a notable Seatrout of 4lbs on a Hitch fly from the Luther pool Mr C Sandground also had a 4lb Seatrout from the Boat pool on a Micro tube. 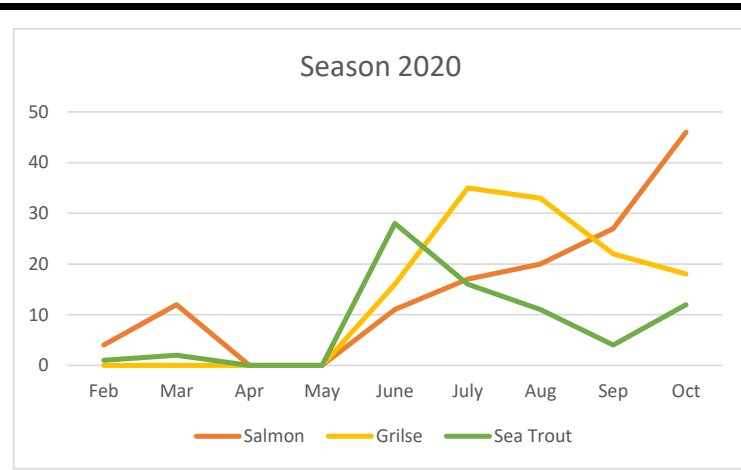

Not far behind was Mr M Selby who had a 13-1/2lb fish from the Boat pool also on a Flying C
<b>Week 2</b> 06-07-20 to 11-07-20	Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 6 Sea Trout = 3 Again the Grilse dominate the returns for the week with Mr J Miner catching 3 for 15lb plus a Sea trout of 3lbs. Mr J Meddings had a 4lb Sea trout from the Luther pool. Mr K MacGregor had the biggest of the week a 15lb fish from the Boat pool on a Pert Shrimp
<b>Week 3</b> 13-07-20 to 18-07-20	Caught this week Salmon = 4 Grilse = 8 Sea Trout = 3 Grilse numbers continue to climb. Biggest fish was 15lb salmon caught on the Boat pool by Mr A Atkins using a Ghillie fly, Mr Atkins also had a 10lb fish, a 3-1/2lb Grilse and 2 Sea trout around the 3lb mark, definately a day to remember.



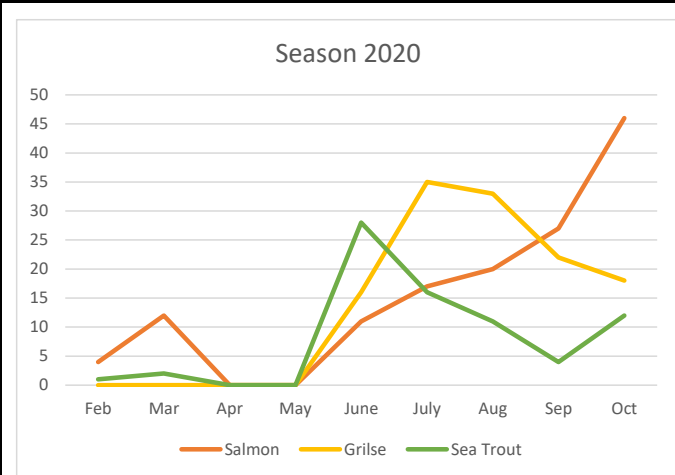

<b>Week 4</b> 24-08-20 to 31-08-20	Caught this week Salmon = 8 Grilse = 5 Sea Trout = 4 Water hight has been fairly consistent and some big fish beginning to appear now. Mr J Murray had a 20lb fish from the Boat pool and Mr A Atkins had a 20lb fish off Lower Weir. Mr W Crawford had a 15lb fish from the Boat pool and Mr M McDougal had a 15lb fish from Bridges. Only 1 salmon and 1 Grilse were retained from the 16 fish total all the other fish were returned. Both fly and spinning methods are working 9 fish were taken on fly and 7 by spinning.





<b>Week 1</b> 01-09-20 to 05-09-20	Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 1 Sea Trout = 0 Slow week this week with only 3 fish caught. Mr K Powel had the biggest fish of the week, a 14lb Salmon from Upper Bridges. Mr P Goodwin had a 10lb fish from the same pool and Mr F Rindle had a 5lb Grilse from the Lutherpool.
<b>Week 2</b> 07-09-20 to 12-09-20	Caught this week Salmon = 11 Grilse = 6 Sea Trout = 2 Better week this week on Pert with a big run of fish entering the system. Again the biggest fish of the week was a 15lb Salmon caught by Mr J Murray, the fish was caught in the Luther pool and took a Hot Tail Flying C.
