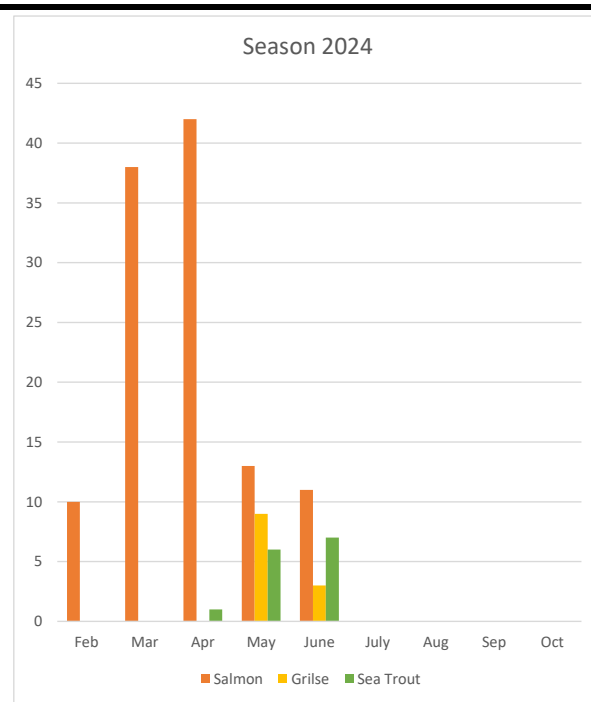


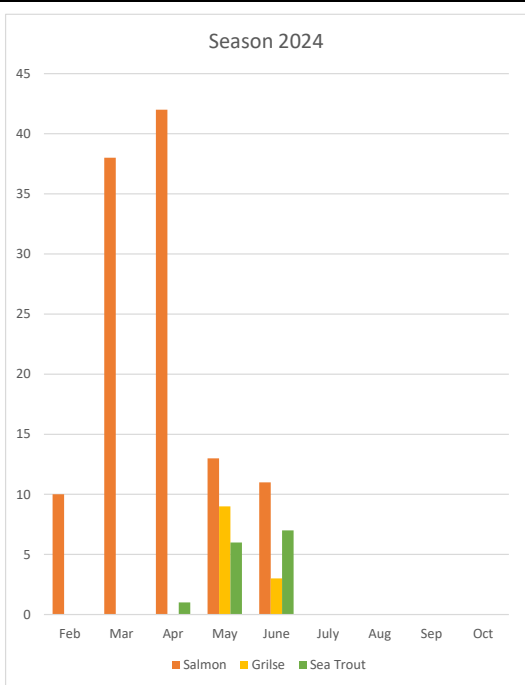


Week 1

Week 3 16-02-24 to 17-02-24	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 6 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0</p> <p>Season is off to a good start this year after the devastation of the winter storms. 6 Springers caught in what could be said as ideal weather with the water at a decent hight and falling away in mild conditions. Biggest fish fell to Mr J Murray from Dundonald a 16lbr from the Boat pool, he also had 2 fish of 8lbs and 9lbs from the Luther pool. Mr S McAbe had a fish of 9lbs from Upper Stobb and Mr N Kinnel had one of 8lbs from the Boat pool. Mr S Guild from Cumnock had a nice 10lb fish from Lower Weir. Conditions are forecast to remain much the same in the coming week so the chances of a fish are pretty good.</p>
Week 4 19-02-24 to 24-02-22	<p>Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0</p> <p>After the flurry of the opening days things have quietend down a little bit. Two nice fish caught this week though, Mr L Sandground took a 12lb fish from the Weir pool and Mr C Inglis had a nice 14lb fish from the Luther pool. Conditions are forecast to be much the same for the coming week.</p>
Week 5 26-02-24 to 02-03-22	<p>Salmon = 3 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0</p> <p>Not prolific fishing yet but the odd fish continues to be caught Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had a 13lb Salmon from the Boat pool and Mr R McGhee took a nice 7lb fish on a Monkey again from the Boat pool and once again from the same pool Mr D Bryce from Shotts had a 6lb fish on a Red Francis.</p>



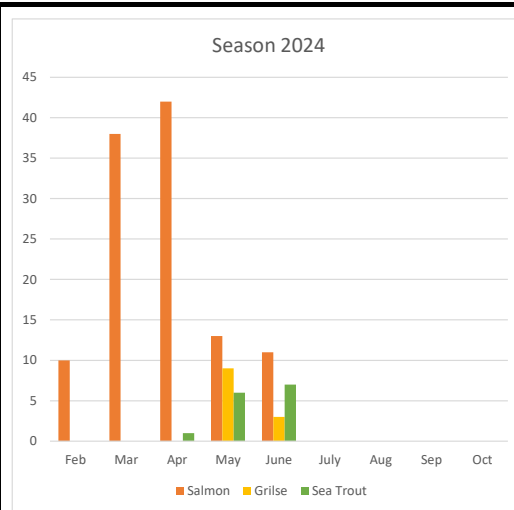


Week 1 04-03-24 to 09-03-24	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0</p> <p>Still the odd fish being taken but they are few and far between at the moment. Me C Candlin from Stirling had the biggest of the week, a 16lb fish from the Mill pool on an Ally's Shrimp. Mr E Anderson from Gloucestershire took a 9-1/2lb fish from the Boat pool on a Monkey and Mr F Calzetta had a 7lb fish from Upper Stobb. Bit of rain is needed to raise the water levels and encourage the fish to run the system. Rain is forecast from Wednesday so heres hoping.</p>
Week 2 11-03-24 to 16-03-24	<p>Caught this week Salmon 4 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0</p> <p>Picked up a little bit this week with 4 fish being caught. Mr R McGhee from Forfar took a 12lb fish from Bridges on a Willie Gunn Mr A Hamilton from Perthshire and Mr S Cocker from East Kilbride both had fish to 8lbs from the Boat pool and Lower Weir respectively. Finally Mr G Smith had a 6lb fish from Upper Stobb. Latest rainfall is not making a lot of difference to water levels but there was a very high spring tide on Wednesday the 13th which may have pushed some fish into the system.</p>
Week 3 18-03-24 to 23-03-24	<p>Caught this week Salmon 13 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0</p> <p>Bit of rain and rise in water levels makes a difference. 13 fish caught this week biggest was 16lbs caught on the Boat pool by Mr D Clelland from Belfast he also took an 8lb fish from Lower Weir. Mr D Hope from Worcestershire took 3 fish of 13, 12 and 6lbs all on a Solar Monkey on Upper Weir and Boat pool. Mr G McClarence from Belfast had 2 fish of 10lbs and 8lbs from Upper Weir and Weir pool. Mr D Forgie had fish of 10lbs and 8lbs from Dovecot. Mr G Wylie from Kirriemuir had 2 fish of 10lbs and 7lbs also from Dovecot and Mr J Murray from Dundonald had a 7lb fish from Blue Stone. Fish are well spread out through the system and with more rain forecast prospects are good.</p>
Week 4 25-03-24 to 30-03-24	<p>Caught this week Salmon 17 Grilse 0 Sea Trout 0</p> <p>Good run of fish came into the beat this week which is reflected in the returns, 17 fish for the week. Mr J Fitsimons from Falkirk had the biggest fish of 16lbs from the Boat pool followed up with a 7lb fish from the same pool. Mr G Smith from Carron had a 10lb fish from the Luther pool as did Mr C Clark from Stonehouse but from Lower Weir. Mr W Rennie from Northern Ireland had 2 fish of 10lbs and 8lbs from the Boat Pool. Mr T McLeary from Coupar Angus had 3 fish to 9lbs all from the Boat pool. Mr G Renwick from Annan had 2 fish to 6lbs both on a Cascade from the Luther pool. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had 2 fish to 9lbs from the Boat pool. Mr C Hood from Lesmahagow, Mr J Miller from Dunbartonshire and Mr C Wayne from Ayrshire all had one fish of 6lbs, 7lbs and 8lbs respectively. The fish are well spread out through the system and with more rain forecast prospects are excellent.</p>



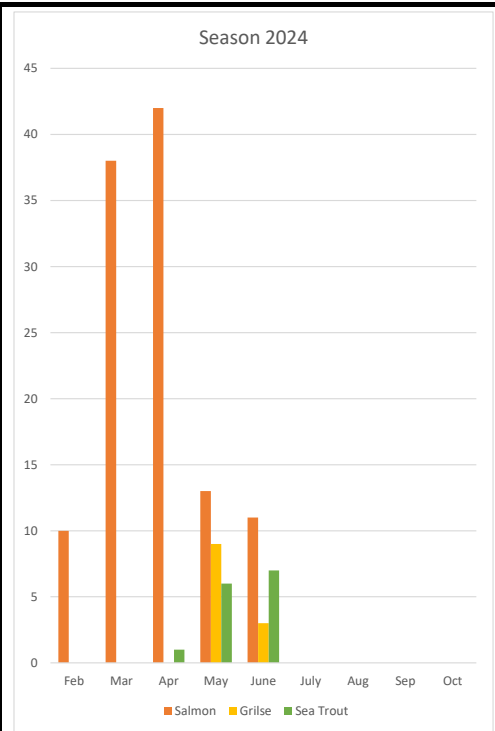


<p>Week 1 01-04-24 to 06-04-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 5 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Heavy rain this week made a couple of days unfishable fish were still being caught when conditions allowed. Mr C MacFarlane from Wymes bay took the biggest fish of the week a 16lb Salmon from the Boat pool run off M r K Lynch from Greenlock had a 2lb fish from Lower Bridges on a Dee Monkey. Mr S Creasey from Ipswich took an 8-1/2lb fish on a Blue and Yellow Tube from the Luther pool and Mr D Leiper from Laurencekirk and Mr W Crawford from Cumnock both had a 7lb fish from Blue Stone and Boat pool respectively. Water is dropping back to a good height after being very high on Saturday so conditions should be good at start of next week.</p>
<p>Week 2 8-04-24 to 13-04-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 14 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Some nice fish are still being caught 11 for the week with the biggest at 13lbs caught on a Yellow Tube at the Boat pool run-off by Mr S Witford from Fife. Mr D Mitchell from Kirkcaldy had a 12lb fish on an Orange tube from the Boat pool and Mr J Miller from Dumbarton had an 11lb fish from Upper Weir on a Banana Monkey and a 6lb fish from Blue Stone on an Orange/Yellow tube. Mr R Wilson from Balloch had two 10lb fish an 9lb and an 8lb fish all on an Alistair from Lower Weir the Boat pool, Dovecot and Lower Bridges. Mr S McAulay also from Balloch took a 10lb fish from Bridges on a Dirty Banana and an 8l fish from Dovecot on an Oyster Catcher. Mr S Guzik from Alloa had an 8-1/2lb fish from Blue Stone on a Cascade. The fish are there to be caught if your lucky with the conditions.</p>
<p>Week 3 15-04-24 to 20-04-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 20 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Well I go on holiday and what happens? the best week of the season occurs, my apologies for not being able to report on it sooner. 20 fish caught this week and some crackers amongst them, i'm not going to be able to mention everybody that caught fish but here's the highlights. Biggest fish fell to Mr G McKinlay from Montrose 25lbs caught on Lower Weir. he also had a 12lb fish from Bridges. Mr M Cowel from Chatton had a 15lb fish from Blue Stone and an 8lb fish from the Boat pool. Mr G Renwick from Annan had a 15lb fish on a Willie Gunn from Blue Stone and a 7lb fish on a Posh Tosh from the Boat pool. Mr C Gorman from Ayrshire took a 12lb fish from Blue Stone. There were a few more double figure fish of 10 and 11lbs taken. For comparison for the same week last season there were 11 fish caught, the North Esk seems to buck the trend and long may it last.</p>
<p>Week 4 22-04-24 to 27-04-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 2 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 0 Feast or famine on Pert with 20 fish caught last week only 2 fish caught this week. Mr G Luke from East Kilbride took a 9lb fish on a Neon Sunray from the Luther pool and Mr J Swanwick from Essex had a 6lb fish also from the Luther pool and that was it. Obviously water conditions and runs of fish come in to play but thats a big difference. Hopefully the wet weather forecast for the coming week will temp fish into the system and we may yet have some consistency of catches.</p>





<p>Week 1 29-04-24 to 04-05-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 7 Grilse = 2 Sea Trout = 1 Picked up again a wee bit this week with 7 Salmon and 1 Sea trout caught. Mr N Brakovich from Warrington had 2 nice fish from the Luther pool of 13lbs and 8lbs. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose also had 2 fish from Upper Weir both weighing in at 10lbs. Mr P Dickinson from Huddersfield took the first Sea trout of the year at 2-1/2lbs from Lower Weir. Mr S Clarke from Staffordshire had a 9lb fish from the Boat pool. Mr T McLeary from Perthshire had an 8lb fish from the Boat pool. Biggest fish of the week fell to a Mr McLeary from Germany a 20lb fish from Lower Weir. Forecast for the coming week is mainly light showers and overcast with temperatures rising to low teens.</p>
<p>Week 2 06-05-24 to 11-05-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 3 Grilse = 4 Sea Trout = 0 The Grilse have made an appearance. 4 Grilse caught this week and 3 Salmon. Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had 2 Grilse to 7lbs from the Boat pool and Mr H Welbourne from Manchester had 2 Grilse both 7lbs and also from the Boat pool, the first Grilse last year didnt appear until the middle of June. Biggest fish of the week was 20lbs caught in the Luther pool by Mr F Calzetta from Stirling. Mr C Chamberlane from Darwen Lancs had an 8lb fish from the Weir pool and a 10lb fish from Upper Weir. The river is quite low at the moment but there are fish holding in the deeper pools.</p>
<p>Week 3 13-05-24 to 18-05-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 1 Too much sun and not enough water made for a poor week. There are plenty of fish in the river but are very hard to tempt. Only 1 Salmon and a Sea trout caught this week Mr G McLarence from Belfast had a 9lb fish from Bridges and Mr G Wyllie from Kirriemuir took a 3-1/2lb Sea trout from the Boat pool on a Silver Stoa. Rain is needed to freshen up the river which is now very low and the forecast is not so good with only light rain forecast for the week ahead.</p>
<p>Week 4 20-05-24 to 25-05-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 0 Grilse = 1 Sea Trout = 2 Still hard going at the moment on Pert. Only 1 Grilse and 2 Sea Trout caught this week. Mr S Guild from Ayrshire took the Grilse weighing in at 3lbs from the Luther pool. Mr C McDonald from Banchory and Mr J Miller from Dumbartonshire both had a Sea trout to 2-1/2lbs one from the Luther pool and one from the Boat pool. Best chance for a fish is in the deeper pools as the river is very low. In saying that it rose last night on the 26th after heavy rain so this coming week may see a fresh influx of fish.</p>
<p>Week 5 27-05-24 to 01-06-24</p>	<p>Caught this week Salmon = 8 Grilse = 4 Sea Trout = 4 Unpredictable at the moment its either a feast or a famine luckily it was a bit of a feast this week compared to the past two. 8 Salmon 4 Grilse and 4 Sea trout for the week. Notable catches were as follows. Mr G McKinlay of Montrose had 16lb fish and a Sea Trout from the Boat pool and a 13lb fish from Bridges. Mr G Donaldson from Ayreshire had a 12lb fish from Upper Weir on a Blue and Black Francis. Mr J Murray from Ayrshire had 2 fish both 8lbs one from the Boat Pool and one from Lower Weir. Mr S Knox from Larbert had a 9lb fish from Blue Stone on a Willie Gunn but fish of the week must go to Master F Rankin from Hamilton who caught a 13lb Salmon at Lower Bridges.</p>





Week 1 03-06-24 to 08-06-24	Caught this week Salmon = 1 Grilse = 0 Sea Trout = 3 Still difficult on Pert this week with fish hard to tempt. One Salmon and three Sea trout caught for the week. Mr A Atkins from Granton on Spey had the 3 Sea trout to 3lbs all on a Micro Tube and Mr A Campbell had a 10lb Salmon on a Blue Elver.
Week 2 10-06-24 to 15-06-24	Caught this week Salmon = 8 Grilse = 3 Sea Trout = 3 Better week this week with 8 Salmon 3 Grilse and 3 Sea Trout caught. Biggest fish fell to Mr J Parsons from Brighton a 20lb fish from Lower Weir caught on a Red Francis Mr K MacGregor from Kircaldy took a 14lb fish from the Weir pool on a Shity Whitey. Mr L Cowell from Alnwick had a 12lb and a 10lb fish from Upper Bridges and two 9lb fish from Upper Weir and the Boat pool while Mr G McKinlay from Montrose had 3 Grilse to 8lbs all from Upper Weir. Mr H Vanbockel from Holland had an 8lb and a 9lb fish on a Cascade both from the Boat pool. Mr G Smith, Mr M Davies and Mr D Russell all had a Sea trout of about 3lbs.
